## Book Review Examples

### 4<sup>th</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade Examples

#### *Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone*

Author – J.K. Rowling

##### What is this book about?

This story is about a boy named Harry Potter. When he was a baby his parents died and he had to go live in his aunt and uncle's house. For a few years his aunt and uncle treated Harry like dirt, and his cousin Dudley kept trying to hurt him.
