

## Clyde Hill Elementary Suggested School Supplies for 2015-2016

### Kindergarten Supplies

**Please do not write students' names on any of the items listed below as they may be shared with the class!**

- One **White ½ inch** binder with clear load front
- 2 **Fine Tip Black Expo** Dry Erase Markers
- 2 **Large Elmer's Brand** Glue Sticks – NO PURPLE GLUE, PLEASE!
- 1 package **Pre-Sharpended Ticonderoga Brand** Pencils
- 20 – 8.5in x 11in. top load clear sheet protectors
- 1 Large Box of Tissues
  
- Last name A-L: one box Ziploc storage bags, **GALLON** sized, one 64-count **Crayola Brand** Crayons, 2 **Pink Pearl** erasers
  
- Last name M-Z: one box Ziploc storage bags, **QUART** sized, one 10 count **Crayola Brand Washable** Markers, one box baby wipes

### First Grade Supplies

**Please do not write students' names on any of the items listed below as they may be shared with the class!**

- four two-pocket plastic/vinyl folders with **prong fasteners**, yellow, red, blue and green
- two one-subject **wide-ruled** spiral notebooks, any color (solid or plain, NO themes/designs)
- one pkg **Crayola Colored Pencils**, 12 count
- 1 pack Expo Dry Erase Markers, black
- two large Elmer's glue sticks (no liquid glue)
- two boxes **#2 Ticonderoga pencils**, **SHARPENED**
- one pkg Magic Rub white erasers
- one handheld pencil sharpener with case for shavings
- one container waterless hand sanitizer with pump, **Purell**
- one large box tissues
  
- Last name A-M: one box Ziploc storage bags, **Quart** sized
- Last name N-Z: one box Ziploc storage bags, **Gallon** sized

### Second Grade Supplies

**Please do not write students' names on any of the items listed below as they may be shared with the class!**

- three two-pocket plastic/vinyl folders, one green, one purple, one red
- two one-subject wide-ruled spiral notebooks, any solid color
- one pkg Crayola crayons, 24 count (or smaller)
- one pkg Crayola markers, 8 or 10 count
- one pkg Crayola colored pencils, 12 count
- one pair Fiskars or Westcott scissors
- one handheld pencil sharpener with case for shavings
- one small plastic supply box, approx 12 inches
- three pkgs thin Expo dry erase markers, black, fine tip, 4 or 8 count
- four Elmer's glue sticks – no purple glue, please
- three boxes #2 Ticonderoga pencils, sharpened
- two pink eraser (handheld)
- two large boxes tissues
- one container hand sanitizer

### Third Grade Supplies

**Please do not write students' names on any of the items listed below as they may be shared with the class!**

- one 1" durable binder
- one pkg pocket dividers with tabs, 8 count
- one two-pocket plastic/vinyl folder, any color
- one composition book, black
- four one-subject wide-ruled spiral notebooks (all solid primary colors)
- one pkg Crayola colored pencils
- two thick Expo dry erase markers, black, chisel tip
- two Elmer's glue sticks
- one pair 5" Fiskars or Westcott scissors, pointed
- one handheld pencil sharpener with case for shavings
- one plastic 12" ruler, standard and metric
- one plastic supply box, able to hold 12 inch ruler (should not be smaller and should not be bigger than the length of a 12 inch ruler)
- three boxes #2 Ticonderoga pencils, sharpened
- two large boxes tissues

A note about brands. Where brands are listed it is because our teachers believe that these brands perform better than their cheaper competitors; for example, that Ticonderoga pencils truly do sharpen better than other pencils.

That said, the suggested brands are not required.

### Fourth Grade Supplies

#### PERSONAL ITEMS:

- one durable 1 1/2" binder, any color. No zipper or Velcro closures. No HUGE binders please.
- one pkg pocket dividers with tabs, **8 or 10 count**
- one two-pocket plastic/vinyl folder, no prongs, red
- one wide-ruled composition book, black
- four one-subject wide-ruled spiral notebooks (2 blue, 2 green)
- one pkg thick Crayola markers, classic colors, 8 or 10 count
- one pkg Crayola colored pencils, 12 count
- two highlighters, 1 blue, 1 yellow
- four thick Expo dry erase markers, black, any tip
- one Sharpie permanent marker, black, fine point
- one Sharpie permanent marker, black, ultra fine point
- three Elmer's glue sticks – no purple glue, please
- one Elmer's liquid glue container
- two ball point pens, 1 blue, 1 red
- two pink erasers (handheld, pink only, **no "toy"/character erasers**)
- one pair 5" Fiskars or Westcott scissors, pointed
- one handheld pencil sharpener with case for shavings
- one **stiff (not floppy)** plastic 12" ruler, **standard and metric**
- one large plastic pencil box (12in x 5in x 2 ½ in preferred)

#### ITEMS TO BE SHARED WITH THE CLASS\*:

- two pkgs wide-ruled filler paper
- three boxes #2 Ticonderoga pencils, sharpened
- one box Ziploc-type storage bags, gallon sized
- two large boxes tissues

### Fifth Grade Supplies

#### PERSONAL ITEMS:

- one 2" white binder with clear top load front cover
- one 2" green binder
- one pkg pocket dividers with tabs, 8 count
- two pink erasers (handheld)
- one pair Fiskars or Westcott scissors, pointed
- one plastic 12" ruler, standard and metric
- one binder pencil pouch

#### ITEMS TO BE SHARED WITH THE CLASS\*:

- two two-pocket plastic/vinyl folders, red and yellow
- one college-ruled composition book, black
- four one-subject college-ruled spiral notebooks, any color
- one pkg college-ruled filler paper
- two pkgs Crayola markers, one thick, one thin, 8 or 10 count each
- one pkg Crayola colored pencils, 12 count
- two highlighters, yellow
- two thick Expo dry erase markers, black, any tip
- three Elmer's glue sticks
- two ball point pens, blue or red
- three boxes #2 Ticonderoga pencils, sharpened
- one container waterless hand sanitizer with pump
- two large boxes tissues
